*The Chain of Lakes Storm-water Park is designed to capture storm-water runoff from the north Titusville drainage system and treat it in a series of engineered wetlands and a pond before the water to enter the Indian River Lagoon. This natural cleansing of the water helps to preserve the seagrass beds of the lagoon. The park was designed and built through a co-operative*

*effort with the St. Johns River Water Management District, Brevard County, the City of Titusville, Eastern Florida State College, and Parrish Hospital. The 97 acre park boasts Soccer Fields, Softball Fields, Pavillions, an observation tower, and a paved multiuse trail winding around the serpentine storm-water lake. The lake itself offers freshwater fishing for Largemouth Bass, Bluegills, Crappie and more. It is best utilized as a catch and release fishery due to the fact it is a storm-water retention facility. It also hosts a variety of birds and other wildlife.*
